

## **SERVICE FEES**

Effective May 1, 2019

---

### **TRAINING**

**PERFORMANCE TRAINING WITH FULL CARE** **\$525/month**

Program includes: 5 days/week of performance training. May include up to 2 lessons/week. Includes full care of blanketing service, feeding of provided supplements, farrier scheduling, vet/health maintenance care, basic meds/deworming service (owner provided or billed), basic clipping/bathing and tails (up to 2x month as needed). Any other services are A La Carte.

**PERFORMANCE TRAINING WITHOUT FULL CARE** **\$425/month – 5 days/week**

**\$325/month – 3 days/week**

This is training rides/long line only - all other services are A La Carte. May include up to 1-2 lessons/week.

**CONDITIONING/MAINTENANCE/LAY UP CARE** **\$425/month**

5 days a week of care/exercise tailored to meet your horse's needs. No riding. Monthly basic clipping/ bathing, farrier and vet/health care.

EMERGENCY CARE - After 5pm Tuesday – Saturday or any Sunday or Monday, hold for vet/services (not included in Full Care)	\$25/hour
LESSONS - additional to training packages	\$25/30-45 mins
TURN OUT	\$10/DAY
LONGE – 15 minutes or more	\$15/DAY
MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION – vaccines, deworming	\$5/up
MONTHLY MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION – Ex: Daily Previcox with your own grain	\$20/month
FARRIER	Billed and payable at time of invoice

## SHOW CHARGES

**Entry Fees:** A Check or sometimes a Credit Card must be given to CLF prior to the close of entries of any show made out to the Horse Show, to be included in the entry sent to the Horse Show. A \$20 fee is charged if CLF has to fill out your entry form.

**Show Charges:** An estimate will be sent prior to the show. These fees must be paid in- full prior to the horse's departure for a show or a payment of schedule of 50% down must be made with payments after the show are allowed. Any fees due after 60 days are subject to a \$25/late charge for every 30 days late. Horse show hauling fees will be added unless prior arrangements have been made. These charges include some of the following at the show: lessons, training, coaching, horse show prep, supplies used, stall cleaning, feeding, bathing, setting up/tearing down, basic show set up, grooms fees, etc...

**Expenses:** An estimate of expenses will be on the show invoice estimate prior to the show. Please remember these are just estimates based on years passed. **Any and all expenses** incurred by your horse are your responsibility and will be billed after the show. These include some of the following: shavings, feed, medications, etc...

## ADDITIONAL HORSE SHOW CHARGES

---

ENTRY FEE PREPARATION	\$20/entry
EQUIPMENT RENTAL (Bridles, clothing, saddles, etc...)	\$50/show
HORSE USE FEE	Non Owners and Non Lessors will be billed a use fee for the horse
SHOW CLIP - basic plus face, legs, ears (not included in Show Fees or Full Care)	\$25
BRAIDING	If hired out - then you will be billed at market price
FEED/SHAVINGS	Any feed/shavings purchased at show will be split and billed
MEDICATIONS	Any medications purchased for you horse will be billed

HOTEL FEES	Hotel fees for trainer and grooms are split and will be billed
ENTRY FEES/EARLY ARRIVAL FEES	Any fees due to the show office will be billed
TACK STALLS	Tack stalls/groom stalls will be divided and billed or paid via entry
LAY OVER	Long trips may require layover and will be billed
SPECIAL DECORATIONS	Any large set up will be pro-rated and billed
MISC.	Any additional expenses will be billed

**Training Fees are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> and considered late after the 5<sup>th</sup>. A \$25 late fee will apply for any fees not received by the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month. CLF now accepts Credit Cards and Bank Pay. If you wish to pay by CC, let me know. There is a 3.6% service fee. These fees will be applied to your next months' invoice.**

### **Important info**

If multiple riders per horse, Add \$100 for a Class A Show and \$200 for Regional/National Shows, then all costs will be split amongst parties. This is to accommodate the additional lessons and show prep.

All show horses must have a Winter Blanket, Sheet, Slinky hood, Standing Wraps and Blanket Bag clearly marked with owner or horse name. If you do not purchase prior to Winter or Horse show, they will be purchased and billed to you.

Please provide a PDF copy via email of the horses Registration Papers, your USEF and AHA cards.

If multiple riders are leasing one horse in Full Training - the fees are split equally amongst the lessors/owners. The 2 lesson rule per week still applies (1 per rider) and any additional lessons are \$25/lesson.

Hotel Expenses and any Special Decorations will be Pro-Rated amongst horses attending show.

Full Training may include 2 lessons per week. Additional lessons are \$25 each. The Training Program is designed to keep your horse exercised and well-schooled. If for any reason your lesson is cancelled - we will do our part to try and accommodate a make-up lesson. However, it is not guaranteed. No roll-over or credits allowed. Your horse will be worked in your or my absence.

CLTC requires a 30 day WRITTEN notice prior to release of client's horse, or next month's fees are fully earned. All unpaid fees must be paid in full in CASH or CASHIER'S CHECK.

Estimated show fees will be billed in advance and are due prior to departure of the show. Any additional costs after the show will be billed and are due upon receipt (ie., shavings, feed, medications). Payment plan of %50/down and the remainder is due after show on a monthly plan.
